## Salah Book

- Names and Timing of Salah (i.e., when do we pray each salah) (page 9 from Salah book)
- Types of Salah (e.g., Fard, Wajib, Sunnah, Nafil) in detail with specific examples you can provide for each type (Page 18 of Salah book)
- Know how to perform a 2 rak'ah salah (pages 24-32 Salah book). Know the steps before and during the salah, positions, the phrases/duas we read and their meaning/translations. In particular, memorize the translation of the following duas:
  - Allahu Akbar - Allah is the greatest
  - A'udhu billahi minash shaijdanir rajim - I seek refuge in Allah from the cursed Satan (shaitan)
  - Bismillahir Rahmanir Rahim - In the name of Allah, the Most Merciful, the Most Kind
  - Subhana rabbiyal azim - Glory to my Lord, the Greatest
  - Sami allahu liman hamidah - Allah hears those who praise him
  - Rabbana lakal hamd - Our Lord, praise be to You
  - Subhana rabbiyal a'la - Glory to my Lord, the Highest
- 12 Fard of Salah
  - 6 Before Salah
    1. Performing wudu/ghusl/tayammum
    2. Cleanliness of body, clothing, and prayer area from any kind of physical dirt/filth
    3. Covering your body (for men between navel and knees, for women whole body except hands, feet, and face)
    4. Direction (facing towards Ka'ba)
    5. Time (every prayer must be prayed within the defined time frame)
    6. Intention
  - 6 During Salah
    1. Starting takbir
    2. Qiyam (standing)
    3. Qiraat (reciting verses from Qur'an)
    4. Ruk'u (bowing)
    5. Sajda (prostration)

6. Qaidah Ahirah (sitting in the last rak'ah until tashahhud is completed)
