

Art Project on Beautiful Names of Allah (SWT) – Due Date: January 21, 2018

Each student must prepare one piece of art work meeting the following specifications:

1. Type of Paper and Size

- Size: 11 inches by 8.5 inches (this is the regular size paper also known as Letter Size).
- Thickness: Construction Paper thickness (Please don't use the regular paper since the paint/color may bleed through; it may also be difficult to hang on the classroom wall)

2. What Should be Included:

- The name of Allah (SWT) in large Arabic letters as neatly as possible. Students can trace the name if they feel their Arabic handwriting is not good/legible.
- The English translation of the name in large bold letters (smaller than the Arabic name)
- The meaning of a verse from the Quran that mentions the name of Allah (see below).

3. Suggestion for Art Work:

- Color the name of Allah (SWT) to make it stand out.
- Use some type of borders around the page (either color or black and white).
- Decorate the art work with stars, glitter, gems, etc.

Please try to be creative (instead of simply copying an existing drawing from the internet or elsewhere) and also try to make it your best work. All artworks will be displayed in the classroom for a period of time.
